In this inaugural issue, the help available to you will be reviewed as well as a couple of cool tips for effective technology integration.

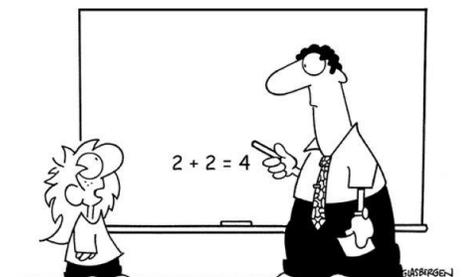
And yes, I am looking for articles from you who are "in the trenches", using technology as a tool for more effective and efficient student learning. Share what you know to help others!

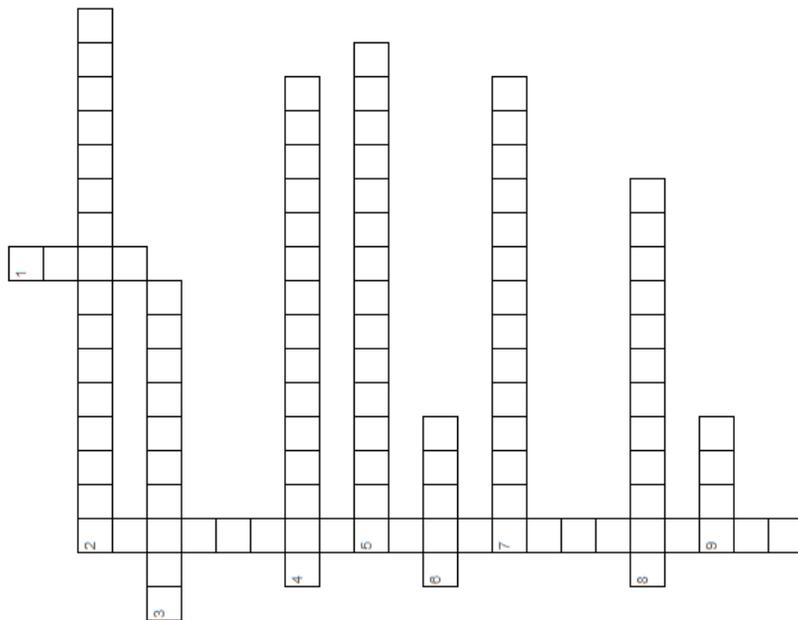
